#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION**

The SKIPPA set top box meets applicable Australian and International Safety Standards. Please read the following recommended safety precautions carefully before operating the product.

#### Mains Supply

The power pack is supplied with this set top box. It operates within the range 100-240 V AC 50-60 Hz mains supply only. Connect the power cable to the set top box before connecting the other end to the power outlet. Disconnect the set top box from the power outlet before connecting or disconnecting the set top box from any other equipment. A well-regulated 12V DC supply is essential for this unit to operate efficiently. Contact IceTV for the recommended DC regulators.

#### Liquids and Spillage

Keep liquids away from the set top box and do not put anything on top of the set top box which may spill (example: lit candles or containers of liquid). Do not use the set top box in extreme temperature and humidity conditions.

#### Cleaning

Before cleaning the set top box, first disconnect the set top box from the mains supply. Use a dry cloth to clean the exterior.

#### Ventilation and Installation

Do not block the ventilation holes and ensure that sufficient free airflow is maintained around the set top box. Never stand the set top box on soft furnishings or on carpet. Do not use or store the set top box near a heater or where it is exposed to direct sunlight. Never stack other heat generating electronic equipment on top of, or below the set top box and always stand the product in a horizontal position.

#### Servicing

Do not attempt to repair or modify the set top box yourself. Do not remove the top cover of the set top box. Any tampering with the set top box will void the warranty. Refer all servicing to IceTV Australia.

#### Lightning

If the set top box is installed in a location that is subject to extensive lightning activity, IceTV recommends that a surge protection device is installed for the set top box mains supply.

#### **Earthing**

The earth/grounding system must comply with local regulations.




#### **CONNECTING YOUR SKIPPA**

Carefully remove SKIPPA from the packaging.

Insert the supplied batteries into the remote control paying attention to the +/-indicators.

See the Quick-Start Guide to connect to your network (or see page 57).


Ensure that all connections are secure before connecting the power pack from SKIPPA to the mains supply. SKIPPA requires a good quality signal from the TV antenna for proper functionality to be achieved.



- ◆ Connect the terrestrial antenna to the Antenna IN on SKIPPA.
- Connect SKIPPA to your TV:
   Option 1: Connect the HDMI cable to the HDMI connector on SKIPPA and then connect the other end of the cable to the HDMI input on the TV.
   Option 2: Connect the Audio / Video (AV) cables to the Audio (white & red) and Video (yellow) outputs on the set top box and the other end to the audio and video (AV) inputs on the TV.
- Screw-on the WIFI antenna if using WIFI to connect to your router, or connect an ethernet cable from the ethernet port on SKIPPA to a free ethernet port on your router.

Make sure you download the IceTV app to use all of SKIPPA's amazing features. The app offers more powerful recording options for SKIPPA than the remote control unit. Please see <u>page 20</u> as well as the <u>IceTV App section</u> of the Reference for an overview of the IceTV app.


Smart Search and Recommendations Service - Trawling through a TV guide takes the fun out of watching TV. IceTV's app gives you total control over searching for and recording free-to-air TV - for up to five PVRs simultaneously. You can also view our recommendations for what's hot this week and discover new shows weeks before they go to air.


Accurate and Smart Recording - Our experienced guide team compiles Australia's most reliable EPG for TV Recorders in order to deliver accurate recordings and facilitate advanced recording options. Set up a preference profile of favourite genres, actors or directors and IceTV will automatically record matching programs - even if they change time slots.

#### THE ICETV PROGRAM GUIDE

Use the custom IceTV program guide to find out what's showing over the next 7 days. You can also set **Recordings**, add **Series**, and set **Reminders** from the program guide. You can access the IceTV guide by pressing with to viewing press either the program of the buttons.





- Move the EPG time-line to the presently watched show (Grey highlight).
- Records the currently highlighted show. The symbol appears next to that show. Press again to cancel the currently highlighted show.
- Add a new Series Recording of the currently highlighted show. The symbol appears next to each episode for that Series. Press again to cancel the Series Recording of the currently highlighted episode.
- Set a reminder for the highlighted show. The symbol appears next to that show. Press again to cancel the reminder.

A reminder window will pop-up on the channel you are currently watching to let you know that the show is about to start. You will then be able to tune directly to that channel, or ignore the reminder to stay on your current channel.

Show only the channels that you have set as your Favourites.

INFORMATION PLATE (1-PLATE)

### **INFORMATION PLATE (i-PLATE)** (i)

The i-Plate displays information about the current and next shows available on that channel, at the bottom of the TV screen.



While watching live TV, press the (i) button to launch the i-Plate.



Press the **UP** and **DOWN** arrows to scroll through the shows that are on for the rest of the day for that channel.

Press the **LEFT** and **RIGHT** arrows to scroll through the shows that are currently broadcast on the other channels. This allows you to browse without having to change the channel you are presently viewing, or pulling up the full EPG.

The i-Plate timeout settings can be changed by going to:



Press (i) again to see the extended i-Plate which contains the description for the show you are presently viewing.

Press ? to show the help legend, which lists all the features and functions for that section.

Press (i) again, or to close the i-Plate.

**CHANNELS** 

#### **CHANNELS**

Using the channel list you can navigate through your channels to set **FAVOURITE** channels, or **BLOCK** or **DISABLE** channels.







Use the arrows to move through the list and highlight a channel. Press to tune to the highlighted channel. Press // 1 to jump to the next / previous page of channels.

- Marks the currently highlighted channel as a favourite. The symbol appears next to that channel. Press Again to un-mark that channel.
- Switches between your favourite channel list and your full channels list.
- Shows the frequency, triplet information, signal strength and quality of the highlighted channel.
- Parental Guidance (PG) blocks the currently highlighted channel. The symbol appears next to that channel. Press again to un-block that channel. Blocked channels require the PG pin to view (default 1234).
- # Disable the currently highlighted channel. The Symbol appears next to that channel. Press # again to enable the channel.

The [NO] symbol indicates that the TV Guide is not available for this channel. IceTV does not supply guide data for the data-casting channels.

**CHANNELS** 

#### **CHANGING CHANNELS**


There are several methods to change channels on SKIPPA:

- Use the buttons to change the channel to the next/prev channel.
- ◆ Open the i-Plate by pressing (i), and then use ∠ / ✓ to navigate up and down to different channels. Press ok to select.
- ◆ Open the TV Guide by pressing , and then use / ✓ to navigate up and down to different channels. Press or to select.
- Enter the desired channel number using the number pad **0-9** on the remote control.

#### **CHANNEL BLOCKING**

This SKIPPA has a channel blocking feature to control viewing in your home. A PG Pin is required to access a blocked channel. Enter the pin when prompted. See *General Settings* for more.



#### **DISABLING CHANNELS**

You can remove unwanted or duplicate channels by disabling them. Once a channel is disabled, you will skip over it when changing channels through any of the methods listed above. The disabled channel will also be removed from the TV Guide.



#### **FAVOURITE CHANNELS**

This feature allows you to create your own favourite channel list for quick access. Pressing while watching live TV will cycle through the channels that you have marked as a favourite.

To mark a channel as a favourite:



#### **VOLUME**

- Use the screen buttons to adjust volume. A volume bar will appear on the and will disappear after 5 seconds.
- ◆ Press ⋈ to mute the volume. A mute icon will appear on the screen and will disappear after 5 seconds.

While SKIPPA is muted, press ? / \ to revert the volume back to its previous level.

#### **CLOSED CAPTIONS / SUBTITLES**




Press (c.c) to enable / disable closed captions and subtitles (when available).

#### **SEARCHING**


A great feature of SKIPPA is the ability to search for a show and set a Recording, Series Recording, or Reminder for that show. You can also search through your recording list to quickly find a show to watch.

Press the (SEARCH) button to launch the search menu.



Type a few letters (e.g. PLA) and all the possible results are listed on top of the keyboard.

Once you see the desired show name (e.g. Play School), press the number (e.g. 2) on the remote that corresponds to this show. All the results for the chosen show are displayed.



#### **SEARCHING**

Filter the results by scrolling \( / \) to either the **EPG** or **Recordings tab**. Highlight a show and press:

- Set a new single recording.
- Add a new Series Recording.
- Set a reminder.
- ok Watch an already recorded show.

Press the button to start a new search.

#### SETTING A RECORDING

#### **SETTING A RECORDING**

You can record a single show, or record an entire series by adding that series to MY SERIES.

#### SINGLE RECORDING

You can create a single recording through the TV Guide, i-Plate, Search, or immediately while watching live TV:

- ◆ Press ( ⇒ select show → B
- Live TV → (i) → select show → (B)
- ◆ Live TV → B
- ◆ (search) → enter show name (OK) → select show → (B)

#### SERIES RECORDING

You can record an entire series by adding a show to MY SERIES, by using the same methods as for a single recording:

- ◆ Press (all be select show ⇒
- Live TV → (i) → select show →
- ◆ Live TV ⇒
- ◆ (SEARCH) → enter show name OK → select show →

#### **PADDING**

Automatically add extra time to the beginning and end of all recordings to cater for broadcast inaccuracies, and to ensure the full show is recorded. e.g. 30 minutes post-padding.

We strongly recommend setting 5 minutes pre-padding for optimal AutoSkip performance.

Press → Settings → PVR → Pre / Post Padding

IceTV offers advanced recording functionality through the IceTV smartphone app and the IceTV website. You get the full IceTV experience with all of our Smart Recording features, as well as remote recording.

Using the IceTV smartphone app or website gets you access to:

- ◆ Q KEYWORDS: Automatically record shows using favourite genres, actors or directors.
- ◆ ❤️ COMING SOON: Discover returning or new shows months ahead of time.
- ◆ ★ FAVOURITES: Identifies when your favourite TV shows are on, e.g. specify "Documentaries" as a favourite, and then pick and choose the episodes to record from the results.

All recordings set via the IceTV smartphone app or IceTV website will automatically be sent to your SKIPPA. This way, you can set your favourite shows to record from anywhere in the world, at any time.




#### **RECORDING ACROSS 3 TUNERS**

SKIPPA has 3 Tuners, allowing you to record 6 separate shows at once across 3 networks. For example you could record ABC & ABC2, SBS & SBS2, and 7TWO & 7mate.

In addition to recording 6 shows at once, you can watch:

- One recorded show from the HDD.
- Any channel within those networks currently recording (and use Chase Play on that channel).
  - A pop-up message will appear indicating that there is a recording conflict if you try to record either more than 6 programs at the same time, or from more than 3 networks at the same time.
  - If you are recording across 3 networks at the same time, channels outside those 3 networks will not be available for viewing.



A message pops up to let you know that the 6 show recording limit has been reached.

#### **RECORDING ACROSS 3 TUNERS**



A pop-up message lets you know that the 3 Tuner / Network limit has been reached.



A pop-up message lets you know that the selected channel is on a network that is not currently available, as all 3 tuners are in use.

#### **CHASE PLAY**

PAUSE, REWIND and FAST FORWARD live TV or a show that is currently recording. As soon as a channel is tuned the Chase Play buffer will begin to record. Changing channels clears this Chase Play buffer and starts a new Chase Play on that channel.

- ◆ If Chase Play is set to ON, the buffer will automatically record up to a maximum of 2 hours behind the live broadcast.
- ◆ If Chase Play is set to OFF, you can still pause live TV to activate the Chase Play buffer. However, you can only rewind the program from the point that you pressed pause.



A Chase Play marker will appear on the i-Plate as you rewind / fast forward the Chase Play program to indicate the current position behind live broadcast.

#### MY SERIES



Displays all the series titles that you have set to record. The episodes from these series that will be broadcast over the next 5 days are automatically scheduled to record, and are shown in MY WEEK. Series that have been created via the IceTV smartphone app or IceTV website will also be shown here.

#### During live TV press




NOTE: Keywords created using the IceTV smartphone app or IceTV website will not be shown here, but the keyword results will still be shown in MY WEEK.

#### To delete the entire Series, press



NOTE: You can also delete series titles via the IceTV smartphone app or IceTV website. All changes to My Series made on your SKIPPA will be reflected in the IceTV app and website, and vice versa.

## RECORDING MY WEEK

### MY WEEK

**MY WEEK** is your personal TV guide for the next 5 days. It displays all the episodes over the next 5 days that match your series titles in **MY SERIES**, as well as all your single recordings e.g. movies.

During live TV press 

OR, Press 

My Recordings → My Week

- ◆ To sort by name / date press
- ◆ To view the show information press (i)
- ◆ To delete the episode press 🛑

NOTE: You can also delete shows via the IceTV smartphone app or IceTV website. All series changes made on your SKIPPA will be reflected in the IceTV app and website, and vice versa.





#### **FAILED RECORDINGS**

Failed Recordings displays shows that have not successfully recorded due to a loss of signal, or loss of power to SKIPPA. You can identify any episode of a series (or single recordings) that may have been missed.

Press → My Recordings → Failed Recordings

- ◆ To sort by name / date press
- ◆ To delete the episode press







My Recordings contains all the shows that have been recorded onto your SKIPPA. You can manage these recordings from this page, including sorting / deleting / grouping and creating playlists to watch your recorded shows.

#### **CREATE A NEW SERIES RECORDING**

Create a new Series Recording of the currently highlighted show. The symbol appears next to each episode for that Series. Press again to cancel the Series Recording of the currently highlighted episode.

### PLAYLIST 🛠

You can build a playlist of your recorded shows, to watch them one after another. This is perfect for when you have recorded an entire series.

Add the currently highlighted show to the playlist. The symbol appears next to each show in the playlist. Press again to remove the show from the playlist.

To start watching your playlist, press play on the first show you added to the playlist. Each recording will then automatically play one after the next.

While watching the playlisted shows, press to open the playlist to navigate between those shows.

### LOCK RECORDING #

You can prevent a recording from being deleted by locking it.

# Lock the currently highlighted show. The symbol appears next to the locked recording. Press # again to unlock.

#### **MOVE RECORDING**


If you need to archive your recording, or want to free up space on your HDD, you can move your recording to an external USB device. Once the recording has been moved, you can play that recording from the USB device by going to **MEDIA**.

Highlight the recording and press then to confirm the move. This will remove any Parental Guidance (PG) block for that recording.

A message will be displayed on the screen once the transfer has finished.

#### **HDD STORAGE**

View the information about your SKIPPA hard drive (HDD). You can see the number of recordings and number of scheduled recordings, as well as the used space and free space available for your future recordings.



To format the HDD, highlight FORMAT HDD and press or

**CAUTION**: Formatting the HDD will permanently erase all your recordings. You will not be able to recover any erased recordings.

#### **PLAYBACK**

- Pause / Resume playback.
- Stop playback and return to the media menu.
- ◆ ¶ PRewind / Fast Forward playback.
- ◆ **〈** / **>** Jump forwards / backwards.
- ◆ Open the playback time-line, use < / > to navigate the time-line forwards / backwards.

# **AUTOSKIP**

#### **AUTOSKIP**

SKIPPA's AutoSkip function is automatically enabled and detects TV adverts in your recorded shows. The detection may take up to one-and-a-half times the duration of a recording, e.g. 45 minutes for a 30 minute recording. If you keep recording another show during the processing time, AutoSkip may take a little longer.

SKIPPA processes your Recordings 1 at a time, prioritising by Genre:

News 1st, Reality 2nd, and Sport 3rd. It will then process by date recorded, starting with the oldest recording.

Press to view your list of recordings.

- ◆ Each processed recording is marked with a Blue Sparkle X. All marked recordings can then be enjoyed without TV adverts.
- ◆ Press information (i) while watching a processed recording to display all detected adverts in a timeline.

We strongly recommend setting 5 mins pre-padding for optimal AutoSkip performance.


SKIPPA offers two modes for you to skip adverts: automatic (AutoSkip Mode) or manual (Manual Mode).

Your remote control has 2 buttons to control the function of these modes:

### **AUTOSKIP**

- ◆ Switch between AutoSkip Mode and Manual Mode by pressing and holding the AutoSkip button for 3 seconds.
- ◆ Press the AutoSkip button to jump to the end of the next adbreak, in either Manual or AutoSkip mode.

SKIPPA is NOT guaranteed to skip all advertisements. For example, AutoSkip won't skip interesting previews of upcoming shows, because we at IceTV don't want you to miss your favourite shows.

Auto-Skip will recognise most ads in pre-produced TV shows, but is less reliable for shows with highly variable content such as the sports genre or where ads blend in with some reality/live shows.

### **UNSKIP**

In rare cases, AutoSkip may skip short program material or play short adverts. If you feel that a program section has been skipped in error, press the **UNSKIP** button to return to the start of the last skipped section.

### MANUAL SKIP (/)

In other rare cases, AutoSkip may miss the end of a TV advert. You can progress to the end of the ad by using the manual skip buttons.


AutoSkip may not be able to process a recording if it is recorded with a poor reception signal. In such cases, AutoSkip will retry to process such a recording. But failing that it will progress to another recorded show and display a failed icon . for the one it could not process. You will not be able to skip adverts automatically for recordings displaying a failed icon on the MY RECORDINGS screen. However, you can still skip adverts with a failed icon by using the manual skip buttons .

# **PVR SETTINGS**

#### **PVR SETTINGS**

Control the settings for your SKIPPA here.





#### **SKIP FORWARDS / BACKWARDS**

Skips playback by specific intervals as an alternative to regular fast forward / rewinding. You can set the interval to one of the following:

5s / 10s / 15s / 30s / 1min / 2min / 3min / 5min / 10min / 15min

While watching a recording press ( / ) to skip.

#### PRE / POST PADDING

In the event that a broadcast starts earlier or finishes later than advertised, you can pad the recording time (pre and post) to make sure you record the entire show. You can set each of these padding times to one of the following:

2min / 5min / 10min / 15min / 20min / 25min / 30min / 40min

We strongly recommend setting 5 minutes pre-padding for optimal AutoSkip performance.

Chase Play temporarily records the channel you are currently watching as soon as you change to it. This allows you to PAUSE / REWIND / FAST FORWARD live TV.

If set to OFF, you need to pause live TV in order to start the Chase Play recording. Only then will you be able to PAUSE / REWIND / FAST FORWARD live TV.

The Chase Play buffer will automatically record up to a maximum of 2 hours behind the live broadcast.

#### SET RECORDING LIFE TIME

You can turn ON automatic housekeeping for your SKIPPA HDD to prevent your HDD from becoming full. Set the number of days for your recordings to remain on the HDD before they are automatically deleted.

If set to OFF, you have to manually delete your recordings in order to free up HDD space for future recordings. The available options are:
